<p>1. Explain to the student that for the agnostic, it isn't possible to establish a connection between things that exist and the God who created them.</p> <p>2. Enable the student to understand that the agnostic questions the concept of time.</p> <p>3. The student should be aware that any philosophical position requires an attitude of faith, or to believe or not to believe.</p>	<p>1. Defining agnosticism.</p> <p>2. Explain to the students that the infinite or eternal cannot be analysed as if he were a series of successive periods of time, according to agnosticism.</p> <p>3. Show the students that the infinite does not have a cause, because he always existed, even before time existed.</p> <p>4.
